Originally Rawhide 112

Opener, Break, Close

Left Allemande the corner - Grand Right and Left around Hand-over-hand until you meet again Swing your lady round and Promenade, take a walk back home When you're there - Sides Face, Grand Square You made my life cheery when you called me dearie Down where the bluegrass grows Your lips were sweeter than julep when you wore a tulip And I wore a big, red rose

Figure

Heads Pass Thru - Separate around one
Line of four, forward up to the middle and back (Star Thru)
Double Pass Thru - Centers In then ...
Cast Off Three-Quarter round a line of four
Slide Thru - Centers Pass Thru - Swing the corner lady
Promenade, heaven knows
Your lips were sweeter than julep when you wore a tulip
And I wore a big, red rose

<u>Tag:</u> Your lips were sweeter than julep when you wore a tulip and I wore a big, red rose

Idea: In the close, call "Side Face, Grand Square Once and a Half". It would dance like:

1 - 2 - 3 - turn - 1 - 2 - 3 - turn - 1 - 2 - 3 - turn - 1 - 2 - 3 - reverse

1 - 2 - 3 - turn - 1 - 2 - 3 - turn - 1 - 2 - 3 - turn - 1 - 2 - 3 - reverse

1 - 2 - 3 - turn - 1 - 2 - 3 - turn - 1 - 2 - 3 - turn - 1 - 2 - 3 - 4 (end with music)
